Hornpipe Speed – 113 \*The winners of our perpetual awards will keep the trophy for one year and must return it to Scoil Rince Riordan no later than three full weeks before the next Scoil Rince Riordan Feis.

- 3) All music competitors must adhere to the general rules of the Feis.
- 4) Competitors must compete in their own age group for solos.
- 5) In Duet or Trio Competitions, at least one competitor must belong to that age group. A competitor may compete in an older age group, but not in a younger one.
